Business Cards	→ Exchange with both hands→ Put cards in a silver case	Do not disrespect or discard cards carelessly
Meetings	Arrive punctually! → Japan 15min. ahead of agreed time → India: At agreed time	
Dining	 → Use chopsticks correctly → Wait for the host to toast → Hold your glass below the host's glass → Limit alcohol consumption (if possible) → When drunk – Be careful, be respectful → Often the host or the eldest pays 	 → Never stick chopsticks upright in rice → Do not reject food (impolite) → Do not argue over the bill → While being drunk: Avoid excessive noise or loud laughter
Public Transport		 → Avoid noisy talk → Don't eat and drink
Gift giving	→ Give gifts	→ Avoid opening the gifts when handed over to you
Patience	→ Show patience in waiting situations	→ Avoid showing impatience or frustration
Gratitude	→ Express gratitude frequently and sincerely	→ Do not neglect to thank hosts or service providers
